PURPOSE: The purpose of this hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed BRIDGE REPLACEMENT, L-16-026, PINEY LANE OVER BROAD BROOK project. All views and comments submitted in response to the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

PROPOSAL: The proposed project consists of reconstruction of Piney Lane over Broad Brook. Piney Lane crosses Broad Brook over a series of 3 pipe culverts. The DOT proposes to remove the culverts and replace them with precast concrete adjacent deck beams. The proposed roadway will match the existing cross section at each abutment and will include 11' travel lanes and 3.5' shoulders for a total curb to curb width of 29' in accordance with applicable design guides.

A secure right-of-way is necessary for this project. Acquisitions in fee and permanent or temporary easements may be required. The **Town of Ludlow** is responsible for acquiring all needed rights in private or public lands. MassDOT's policy concerning land acquisitions will be presented in the hearing.


