The incendiary part of the movement seems to be Cameron's claims of "indoctrination" in the public school system. Resident Kelly Kapinos was present at the meeting to speak against the book reading.

"I belong to a church," Kapinos said, "I'm an army brat, I'm a patriot. My father fought for people to have the right to do this – he fought for the right for people to kneel at football games."

"The book isn't the problem," Kapinos said. "I went to BraveBooks.com; Kirk Cameron has a three-minute video, and the first sentence is that 'we're trying to stop indoctrinating our children.' That is where I have the issue."

"There are families that are two moms and two dads, and we represent all of them," Kapinos said. "The way they portray that for three minutes, the way he talks about what they're trying to do, is they're trying to get people to all believe that there's only one way to have a family, and that is just not what's real. It hasn't been real for hundreds, thousands of years."

Burek chose not to comment on the references to "indoctrination," though she said what she heard from the initial commercials was "nothing like what I'm seeing now."

"What I'm seeing now is more push toward the far-far-right," Burek said. "There seems to be no in-between. The word moderate has gone out the window."

To people intending to protest the event, Burek said, "I would ask them to listen. I would invite them to listen to the stories that are being read, and understand that I have no ill intent whatsoever."

For the folks that plan to attend the event, Burek said "Bring lawn chairs, bring blankets."

"I will be providing waters," Burek said, "I just want everybody to come out and have a great time."
