Eligible electricity consumers not already enrolled with a competitive electric supplier would be automatically enrolled in the Program unless they chose to opt-out, in which case they would continue to receive basic service provided by their electric distribution company, NSTAR Electric Company d/b/a Eversource. The Department docketed this petition as D.P.U. 24-52.


